How does it work?

All that you need to access the system is a PC with Broadband Internet connection, sound/speakers and Flash Player.

You will be given a link and access codes for the manager and for trainees. Simply enter the relevant codes into the boxes on the log on page and click the 'log on' button.

When they first access the system trainees will enter their details in order to set up their personal account. Once this has been done, the system will store their details and recognise them each time they subsequently log on. This information allows you to identify those staff that have completed training.

Individual trainees can view their own training results but the 'Manager Users' of the system are the only ones who can view the results of *all* trainees.

In between every section of each course, the trainee is given a mini test to provide interaction during the training and to ensure that he or she has grasped the main learning points.

At the end of each training course, the trainee will automatically be directed to an end-of-programme test where he or she is asked to select and submit an answer to each question presented.

If the trainee successfully passes the test, the system automatically generates a pass certificate. This document includes the trainees name, the title of the training programme and the date of the test. The certificate can then be printed off if required.

The Administration & Results module enables the Manager User to control and administer the training. For example he/she can:

- Decide what training different trainees will receive
- Create training groups
- Allocate access to specific programmes for each training group
- Allocate access to specific programmes for individual trainees
- Easily issue training alerts / reminders
- Monitor trainee progress and activity
- Analyse training results
- Update or amend data (i.e. trainee details, passwords, etc) as necessary
